Miami Beach Bans City Travel to North Carolina, Mississippi
– Resolution Passes Unanimously –

Miami Beach, Fla. - Miami Beach Mayor Philip Levine and Commissioners voted unanimously today to pass a resolution to ban official city travel to North Carolina and Mississippi. The resolution, sponsored by Mayor Levine, further imposes a moratorium on the purchase of goods or services sourced in those states until the discriminatory legislations these states have adopted against the LGBT community are either repealed or declared unconstitutional by a Court of Law.

“I am proud that my colleagues stand behind me to send this message on behalf of the City of Miami Beach--that we will not tolerate this discrimination,” said Mayor Philip Levine. “The City of Miami Beach stands in support of our LGBT community and will further push to achieve equality in all of our country.”
