**Final Vote: Miami Beach Minimum Living Wage Ordinance**  
*– At Tomorrow’s June 8 City Commission Meeting –*

**Miami Beach, FL:** The Citywide minimum living wage ordinance, proposed by Mayor Philip Levine, will be voted on during second reading on June 8, 2016. This proposed ordinance received unanimous support from the Miami Beach City Commission on first reading.

The proposed legislation would gradually raise the minimum living wage from \$8.05 per hour, as mandated by Florida’s Minimum Wage Act, to \$13.31 per hour over a period of four years.

Miami Beach would become the first city in Florida to establish a citywide minimum living wage with this phased-in approach.
