City Manager Morales to Host Business Roundtable on Immigrant Integration

MIAMI BEACH — On Thursday, Miami Beach City Manager Jimmy Morales will hold a business roundtable to provide a briefing on the impact of immigrants to the region and workforce and discuss the role of area employers in immigrant integration.

Morales will speak to the business and economic impact of initiatives for immigrant workers such as *New American Workforce*, which works with businesses to assist their eligible immigrant employees with the citizenship process so they become full participants in the workplace, community and economy.

One of the first cities to sign on to *New American Workforce*, the City of Miami Beach was also the first partner to fully fund the application process of ten employees who [became U.S. citizens](#) in March.
