All members of a City of Miami Beach board or committee are invited to attend a free ethics training that will be given by the Miami-Dade Ethics Commission and the Office of the Miami Beach City Attorney. The training will include a review of the Sunshine Law, the Public Records Act, the County's Conflict of Interest/Code of Ethics Ordinance, and Financial Disclosure filings.


