Get Ready for the August 20, 2024 Primary Election

The August 20, 2024, Primary Election is approaching, and we want to ensure that all registered voters are well-prepared to participate in this important civic duty. Here is what you need to know to make your voting experience as smooth and informed as possible:

Review Your Customized Sample Ballot: Before heading to the polls, take the time to review your customized sample ballot. This will allow you to familiarize yourself with the candidates running for Federal, State, County, and Municipal offices, as well as any ballot questions.

You can access your sample ballot online at www.miamidade.gov/elections/voter-information.asp by entering your first name, last name, and date of birth.

Important Dates to Remember:

- New voters must register or change party affiliation by Monday, July 22, 2024.
- The deadline to request a Vote-By-Mail Ballot is 5:00 p.m. Thursday, August 8, 2024.
 Remember to renew your vote-by-mail request for the 2024 election cycle. After requesting a Vote-By-Mail Ballot, you can track its status to ensure it has been received and counted. Visit here and follow the instructions provided to track your ballot.
- Early Voting will occur from Monday, August 5, 2024, through Sunday, August 18, 2024.
 Check the schedule of early voting locations online. During Early Voting, you may vote at any of the twenty-three Countywide Early Voting sites. The City of Miami Beach Early Voting sites are located at:

Free parking has been reserved for early voters at both the Miami Beach City Hall Garage and the North Shore Branch Library. *The City Hall Garage (G7) is located at 1755 Meridian Avenue. The entrance to the City Hall Garage is located on 18th Street between Meridian Avenue and Convention Center Drive.

Election Day is Tuesday, August 20, 2024, with polls open from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. A list
of Miami Beach polling places is available <u>online</u>. Registered voters who choose to vote on
Election Day must vote at their assigned polling place.

Secure Vote-by-Mail Drop Boxes

You do not even have to go inside! Vote-by-Mail ballots can be dropped into a secure Vote-by-Mail Drop Box located outside any Early Voting site, including the two Miami Beach Early Voting locations. Just look for the "Official Ballot Drop Box!" banner. Drop boxes are drive-up and are safe. A secure Vote-by-Mail Drop Box will be available and staffed at each Early Voting location during Early Voting hours of operation.

Stay Informed: For those who prefer to receive their customized sample ballot via email before each election, you can sign up by calling 305.499.VOTE (8683).

Voter Assistance Available: If you require assistance during the voting process, accessible voting equipment will be available at all polling locations.

When voting at any voting location, whether it is Early Voting or Election Day, be sure to bring a current and valid identification that contains your name, photograph, and signature. While it is not required that you bring your Voter Information Card to the polling place, it will expedite your checkin process.
