Free parking has been reserved for early voters at both the Miami Beach City Hall Garage and the North Shore Branch Library. *The City Hall Garage (G7) is located at 1755 Meridian Avenue. The entrance to the City Hall Garage is located on 18th Street between Meridian Avenue and Convention Center Drive.

Vote-by-Mail Drop Box

You don't even have to go inside! Vote-by-mail ballots can be dropped into a Secure Ballot Intake Station ("Vote-by-Mail Drop Box") located outside all 33 Early Voting locations. Just look for "Official Ballot Drop-Off."

When voting at any voting location, whether it is Early Voting or Election Day, be sure to bring a valid identification that contains your name, photograph, and signature. While it is not required that you bring your Voter Information

Card to the polling place, it will expedite your check-in process.

Registered voters who choose to vote on Election Day must vote at their assigned polling place.
