The purpose of this Letter to Commission is to update you on the status of the City of Miami Beach's Prekindergarten (PreK) Scholarship Program for Miami Beach residents. The Prekindergarten Scholarship Program expands hourly access to high-quality PreK providers for 177 families with a scholarship of up to \$3,000.

Staff from the Office of Education and Performance Initiatives oversee this scholarship program as it enters its fourth year of implementation. There are 177 PreK families receiving the scholarship in the 2024-2025 school year at a funding of \$485,000 and 22 PreK providers participating (attachment A).
