#### V. Special Guest: Commissioner Laura Dominguez

• Comm. Dominguez addressed the Committee and discussed upcoming updates being made to the Transportation Modal Master Plan of 2015, the Beachwalk, traffic striping and solar powered speed limit signs being placed on the Beachwalk, additions to the bike lanes throughout the city, modernizing the trolley system. She recommended that the committee focuses on High Impact Weekends. She mentioned that PD is installing CCTV cameras on the Beachwalk up to 63<sup>rd</sup> Street. She also thanked the Committee for its hard work and dedication. Discussion held.

### VII. Items Requested by Members

#### • Discussion w/ MBPD RE: Rules & Enforcement of Motor-Scooters (P. Matos & E. Dias)

Sgt. Alexander Torres addressed the committee and discussed enforcement efforts regarding e-bikes/scooters. He mentioned that a meeting was held with Comm. Bhatt discussing ideas and implementation of e-bike/scooter enforcement and how to best address issues with the resources available. Ofc. Julio Blanco discussed additional enforcement efforts for e-bikes/scooter as well as concerns MBPD has received from the public but stressed the need for dedicated lanes for e-mobility and educational resources/campaigns available to the public which would help deter e-mobility users from breaking traffic laws on the road. Over 400 citations were issued to bicyclists and e-mobility from Jan. 2024-present and only one major incident involving injuries in the last 3 years.

An LTC from the TPBPFC that was submitted to the Commission regarding a separate, alternate path on the Beachwalk specifically for bicycles and pedestrians was submitted May 2023. Discussion held.

• J. Saunders moved; H. Burstein seconded to table the topic of an alternate, separate pedestrian path on the Beachwalk as an agenda item for the next TPBPFC meeting to make a clear recommendation to the Commission in the form of an updated LTC; would like to further discuss with City Staff. Motion passed.

# • Miami Beach Bicycle Pedestrian Master Plan Review (M. Gellman)

 M. Gellman addressed the committee and asked about gaps within the Bike Path network. Transportation discussed many physical and fiscal challenges faced with completing the bicycle path network and looking at the easiest gaps to fill to be able to progress with the Master Plan while working out how to proceed with areas that are more complex. Transportation mentioned that this is being presented at the Sept. 2024 Commission Meeting. Discussion held.
