Fire Inspector	\$85.00
Fire Officer	\$120.00

### ADMINISTRATIVE/EQUIPMENT FEES *(hourly)*

Fire Administrative Fee of \$15 hourly per employee. Applied to events in accordance with City of Miami Beach Appendix A FY 2025 Fee Schedule.

The Miami Beach Fire Department is not obligated to provide off-duty services and reserves the right to provide them at their sole discretion. Payment shall be expected in advance for all fees charged and made payable to the City of Miami Beach. Acceptable methods of payment can be established by contacting the Miami Beach Fire Department Fire Prevention Division.

Staffing requests should be made 14 days in advance. Requests made with less than 24-hour notice may incur additional fees. Cancellations shall be made with at least 24-hour notice. Cancellations can be made by phone or email during business hours Monday to Friday 8am to 5pm. A 4-hour minimum charge shall apply to cancellations made with less than a 24-hour notice.

Fire department personnel remain employees of the Miami Beach Fire Department while performing off-duty services. The event is limited to the general assignment of duties and retains no authority over fire department personnel. Fire department personnel engaged in providing off-duty services during the event shall remain in an off-duty status until services are rendered and additional time shall be paid by the event. Fire department personnel providing service after being released from the event will revert to an on-duty status.
