The following is a list of documents required for the processing of all barge display fireworks permit applications:

- Barge fireworks displays must be permitted by the U.S. Coast Guard and shall conform to USCG regulations, Title 46, CFR. Contact USCG Sector Miami, Waterways Management Division at 305-535-4317 for USCG marine event planning information. [Marine Event Form Submission \(uscg.mil\)](http://uscg.mil) Please provide a USCG permit approval letter or No Permit Required Letter (NPRL) with application.
- A satellite image/detailed site plan that includes:
 - GPS coordinates and square footage of actual launch site.
 - Minimum Secured Diameter of Site (70 feet per inch of largest aerial shell).
- Materials list showing the type, quantity, and size of all display fireworks.
- Non-refundable permit application fee of **\$429.00** paid at time of application submittal.
- Copy of valid U.S. Department of Justice Bureau of ATF Federal Explosives License/Permit (18 U.S.C. Chapter 40)
- Copy of valid driver's license for all display operators and assistants.
- Resume of display operator that shows experience with display fireworks.
- Certificate of Insurance:
 - Commercial General Liability limits of \$1,000,000 and Automobile Insurance of \$1,000,000 minimum.
 - The City of Miami Beach must be listed as a **CERTIFICATE HOLDER** and **ADDITIONAL INSURED**.
 - The City of Miami Beach must be specifically listed as an Additional Insured.
 - Certificate holder block must display **City of Miami Beach 1700 Convention Center Drive Miami Beach, FL 33139.**
 - Proof of Worker's Compensation. Companies employing more than (3) three employees are required to carry Workers Compensation insurance per Florida Law.
 - If you do not carry Workers Compensation because you do not meet above criteria you can provide us with a letter stating such exemption.
- Complete permit applications shall be submitted (14) days prior to event.

Permit must be on site during all phases of operation
